Paramedics and an ambulance were dispatched, and the rider was transported to University Medical Center. An objection was filed by the rider of the #4 UR MY FAVORITE against the #5 MR PURA VIDA alleging interference after the start. The stewards were notified of the objection after the race had been declared official, so no action was taken,


Race 6: There was a significant delay in the running of the 6th race while the injured rider was being attended to by medical personnel on the track.
