Race 7: STEWARD INQUIRY/DQ: Following the running of the race the stewards posted the inquiry sign due to an incident mid-stretch involving fifth place finisher **#3 Sharp Dressed Gal** ridden by Alex Cruz, third place finisher **#6 Trinni**, ridden by Chad Lindsay, and sixth place finisher **#11 Coastal Curves** ridden by Leslie Mawing. After reviewing the videos and taking testimony from the riders involved the stewards determined that **#3 Sharp Dressed Gal** came out sharply under the left hand use of the riding crop causing **#6 Trinni** to steady between horses and bump into **#11 Coastal Curves** who in turn broke stride. The stewards' decision was to disqualify **#3 Sharp Dressed Gal** from fifth position to sixth position for costing **#11 Coastal Curves** the opportunity of a better placing. The original order of finish of 8-10-6-9-~~3~~-11-1-5-7-2-4 was changed to 8-10-6-9-11-~~3~~-1-5-7-2-4. Jockey Alex Cruz was asked to appear before the board of stewards for a film review. **#4 Flower Heart Deer** was eased near the wire and walked off.

The official order of finish is as follows: 2-5-3-1-7-6-9-4-8-10. Jockey Sahin Civaci was asked to appear before the board of stewards for a film review. **#10 Pickett's Deelite** was distanced and put on the stewards list.
